

MASK/COVID 19 UPDATE: The Kent and Ottawa County Health Departments have communicated that the public health order requiring facial covering in PrK-6th grade was written to expire 60 days after a vaccine has been made available for 5-11year-olds. The current order will expire during Christmas break and before students return to school on Jan.3. Provided there are no unforeseen changes, on January 3, 2022, the Diocese of Grand Rapids will continue to strongly recommend the use of facial coverings inside all school buildings regardless of vaccination status.
