## Here's a question for you: "Should we clap for the Choir?"

Our children's choirs have the most beautiful sound and they only get better as the year goes by! When they come to sing at a weekend Mass, sometimes we clap after their "special song" and sometimes we don't. Is it a big deal to clap for our kids at Mass? Yes, it is. **And we shouldn't do it.** 

The Mass has incredible moments designed into it, and communion meditation (particularly) is an especially reverent, prayerful time. The music in that moment is meant to inspire the parish to fall more deeply into prayer. Applause, as you can imagine, breaks this mood. Holding our applause during holy Mass shows the children they gave us something spiritual, which is more powerful than a performance. We can quietly absorb the moment our children turn and minister to US, experiencing their gifts and melting closer to God. ## Hello IHM Families!



I hope you have had a chance to read the letter we sent out from Father Troy yesterday. It is so important that we, as a faith community come together on the weekends to celebrate Mass and all work together to keep our Parish running smoothly. There are many needs for volunteers that didn't get refilled when some of those COVID restrictions started to lift. We work so hard during the school day to immerse the children in Catholic teachings and nurture their relationships with God. We want to complement the work you are doing at home and work together to make saints! Many parishes have seen a decline in tithing since COVID, but as costs increase, that support is more and more important, both for the parish and the school.

To earn parishioner status for tuition at school, families commit to regular attendance at Mass on the weekend, saying active in parish ministry, and consistent tithing. I've been listening to the Bible in a Year podcast from Fr. Mike Schmitz and a few weeks ago, he talked about participation in parishes. He said the average is that 7% of parishioners are doing the bulk of the work of sustaining the parishes through tithing and volunteering for various ministries. He makes the point that even increasing 1% to 8% would do so much good for our parishes! Here at IHM, I'm sure we are already overachievers, but we can certainly welcome more and more parishioners/school families to be more active with regular Mass attendance, tithing, and church activities. This is an extremely active Parish, with so many opportunities for people to get involved. It is the responsibility of all of us to ensure IHM Parish is here and thriving for many years to come. We want our children and grandchildren to benefit from growing and practicing their faith in this special, welcoming community.
