

**TRIDUUM BEGINS** Sundown on Holy Thursday to sundown on Easter Sunday is considered the most solemn part of our liturgical year. This three-day period, the *Easter Triduum*, marks the sacred recounting of Christ's last three days on earth. "Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery" (USCCB). Note the services and times listed above. 
