GROWING OUR FAITH AT HOME: The Catholic

Church urges us to spend time in prayer for those

who have gone before us, especially during the first eight days in the month of November. Visiting a cemetery, for even the briefest of times and praying for the souls in Purgatory is a requirement of Christian charity, and it helps us to call to mind our own mortality. Plan now to incorporate a daily trip to the graves of loved ones from November 1-8th. Family members buried out of town? Ask your friends for directions to the graves of their loved ones buried locally. Once there, encourage everyone say this prayer aloud or quietly. "Eternal rest grant unto her/him O Lord, and Let perpetual light shine upon them. May his/her soul and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. You needn't know those you're praying for. And you can return to the same cemetery on each of the 8 days. There is no exact protocol for praying for the dead, just that we do, knowing one day we will

need someone to pray for us.
