Hello IHM Families!

What an amazing auction last weekend! It was so well done and everyone was so gracious and generous! Thank you again to Lindsay Lowery and Nicole Kakaty and many, many others for all their hard work. Our Fund-A-Need was to focus on funding some safety initiatives. We had a consultant assessment last week for our buildings in anticipation of some state funds for safety projects and he was very impressed with our current level of security and the things we have planned. We already have windows with the protective film (you may remember the big grant a few years ago that made that possible), our classrooms have proper locking mechanisms (With the extra "Nightlock" security door stoppers), our newer double entry point with access only through the main office, and well-identified rooms and doors. With the fund-a-need from Home and School, we are paying for the key card entry system so

that we can make all the doors without that security feature an exit only door with no handles or locks. We are getting phones in each classroom for emergency purposes and we are getting better signage for the main entrance. This will ensure any emergency responders would clearly see the main entrance as well as visitors so that they aren't wandering around the building looking for the main entrance. Please continue to be diligent about keeping our doors closed and locked when school is in session and always entering through the main doors. Our Home and School funds will also purchase an updated audio enhancement system for classrooms that is current technology and plays nice with our Clevertouch boards from the last auction!

We are so blessed here. I am so grateful for the opportunities to continue to make improvements to the school for our kids. Have a great weekend!
