

ATTENTION: ATTENDANCE REQUEST Please be sure to report your child's tardy or absence before 8:00 am to the school office using the IHM App or email attendance@ihmschoolgr.org. The office will gladly notify your child's teacher of his/her absence. If the school office does not receive notification, it will be considered unexcused for attendance purposes. All tardies or absences must be reported to the school office EACH day your child is absent. You may also use the APP to report late arrivals due to doctor/dentist appointments or early dismissals.

If you are pulling up in the carline just before 8am, your children are already late. An occasional tardy happens. Daily tardies are inconsiderate. Be advised: Next week you will receive an email from SCHOOLADMIN with a link to re-enroll. You must pay the administration fee, online, before your students will be fully

enrolled. Current families will be given approximately 2 1/2 weeks to reenroll their current students and add new ones. Demand is HIGH for our preschool classes so don't delay enrolling those 2 weeks before all grades are open to others.
