Hello IHM Families!

Happy St. Patrick's Day! We enjoyed some Irish dancing this morning and everyone is so festive in their green!

I'm so excited to share that we have hired a part time Assistant Principal beginning next year. Mrs. Anne Brown, a former parent and Board member is retiring from her position in Kentwood as a middle school and bringing her 30 years of experience to IHM. She is excited to serve this community that she loves and continue to make a difference in kids' lives! We are so blessed to have her!

It is so important, to keep the procedures for drop off and pick up through the whole school

year. Students are NOT to be dropped off at the corner of the gym building or anywhere in that main parking lot. You must continue to the drop off area that is supervised. I see kids walking through that parking lot where cars may not see around another car, or cars are trying to turn around to go back out onto Burton. You can continue after the drop off area and circle around. It will only add 10-15 seconds to the process, but it is imperative for the safety of our kids. After school you must park and walk over to where your child is waiting OR get in the car line. The side of the building by the DeMazenod entrance is not a pick-up location. We are responsible for the safety of our campus. I appreciate so much those who always follow these protocols. It's important that all of our 180 families do so. Have a wonderful weekend! It looks like we might finally get a warm-up next week!
