### Jesus, I Trust in You



When Our Lord began to appear to St Faustina in 1931 as the KING OF DIVINE MERCY, he was wearing a white garment with red and pale rays emanating from his Sacred Heart. The pale stands for the water which makes souls righteous and the red, for the blood which is the life of souls. "I am sending you with My mercy to the people of the whole world," He told her. "I do not wish to punish mankind, but I desire to heal it, pressing it to My merciful Heart." Jesus requested a special feast devoted to his Divine Mercy take place on the second Sunday, a day in which he would pour special graces out on the whole world, including the full or partial remission of the temporal punishment of sin for all who intentionally participate in this feast and implore His Divine Mercy. It includes a good confession shortly before or after the feast day, Holy Communion on the Feast Day and veneration of His Divine Mercy image (Above). Once a year, we are given the chance to not only have our sins forgiven, but to have deleted the time required in purgatory to purify us of those sins.
