We are down to three weeks of school left! Even less for the 8th graders! You can certainly feel the excitement in the building!

We are looking forward to next year! You are aware of the openings in middle school for math and history/religion. We are so grateful to Mr. Emmett McDaniel for filling in for middle school math for the last several months. He has decided to pursue other opportunities next year. I hope he will be able to be back to sub occasionally! Last week I let you know that Mrs. Jaymie Perry was heading to a position at Catholic Central. We are making good progress with these positions. We are also hiring a

full-time preschool teacher to accommodate our growing program over there and a part time teacher to share 6th grade responsibilities (as there will be 2 groups next year).

As both a teacher/administrator for the last 27 years and a parent for the last 16, I want to share the process the teachers go through each year to place children in classrooms for the next year. First, there is a lot of praying, then the teachers look at several factors in placing students including the balance of the class, teaching styles, special needs, and mix of personalities. This is just a few factors to consider. Please trust in this process for your child as the teachers know them very well in the school setting. We have amazing teachers in this building. They are all gifted in different ways and the kids learn different things from each of them.
