http://studentfinanacialaid.blackbaud.school . If you are applying for the very first time, create an


account. If you already have an account, your application will roll over into this next school year 2024-45. Your user's name and password will be the same. **Our school code ID is 12006**

The School Safety Grant is annual, and it requires community input, which is why you received a survey to take with any ideas you might have. Know that we have formally had the campus evaluated for safety and security by professionals and law enforcement twice since I have been here. We use all that information to decide what priorities to set for purchases and upgrades related to school safety. This includes mental health initiatives. Your part of the safety and security is to make sure you only enter the school through the office, get a visitor badge if you are going further into the building, and never prop open doors.
