It's been a wonderful full week of school! Our staff had an amazing Professional Development Day last week on Friday. We spent the morning with the entire staff of teachers and paraprofessionals working through our emergency drill process for lock downs with Troy from Secure Environment Consultants. This is the company that did our full security assessment a year

ago and provided recommendations for the campus. They have also provided some other "tabletop" trainings for teachers regarding various scenarios a school might experience as an emergency. These have been very well done and allowed us the opportunity to look at all our processes to plan, to the best of our ability, how to prepare ourselves and our environment for a variety of emergencies. Friday, we spent some time learning best practices and then went through a simulation of an intruder in the building using our lockdown drill procedures. It was so helpful to evaluate all our processes and plans. We are continuing to work on safety wherever we can!

Teachers then spent the afternoon pouring over curriculum standards and mapping out those standards during the school year in the different grades. Teachers really don't have much time to do this important work during the school year as they are focused on their kids, so this was also so helpful for teachers to have time to collaborate together!
