



IHM 8th Grade Countdown Begins


With the celebration of our patroness at Wednesday morning May

Junior High Science Fair 2024 Winners





Eighth-grader **Isabella L.** (left) gave her second-place solution to the query "Can nanotechnology help clean up ocean oil spills?"


Seventh-grader **Darren O**.'s (right) 3rd place project took on the age-old debate "How does rinsing the dishes affect the cleanliness of the plates?"
