From the Principal:

Hello IHM Families, We are getting into the swing of things for the 24-25 school year! It was definitely a hot one, and we're excited that the building will be able to cool down a bit now looking at the forecast. In the Spring of 2023, we started a new policy regarding cell phones at school. Before that students were able to bring phones and keep them in their lockers. But when we started that in March of 2023, students had to drop their cell phones in the office if they brought them into the building. As awareness has grown recently about the detrimental effects of the phones with children, many schools are taking these necessary steps to have a phone free environment at school. We sent an app notification in early August referencing the book "The Anxious Generation" and the book club hosted by West Catholic. This way students and teachers can focus on the learning during the day. To that end, the Diocese of Grand Rapids has written a policy to support schools in their efforts to keep phones out of the school environment. The policy is here for you to read.

There is growing evidence that children should wait to get smart phones until high school at a minimum. We are working together with other Catholic schools to try to provide education for parents around this issue. There is so much going on outside of school hours with texting, messaging and social media that spills over into the school day. Parents might try to keep their child away from smart phones, but then when half the class has them and half doesn't, it only compounds the problems.

When students are at school we have filters and other safeguards in place that are difficult at home. We will often share tips and strategies for parents and <u>protectyoungeyes.com</u> is a wonderful resource for this.

We are so thankful for a community that

is vigilant in protecting kids and maintaining the focus that our children are gifts from God. Our faith is the reason for everything we do. Here is a great article about how Catholic schools are keeping this as a focus as the technology world changes around us.
