

Enrollment for the coming IHM 2025-26 school year is right around the corner. Final approval of tuition costs have been made, financial aid and parish support is being applied, and contracts are being generated. ALL CURRENT IHM FAMILIES will be afforded the opportunity to re-enroll their students (and add new ones) before we move to OPEN ENROLLMENT. Let the Children Stay Home

Seems like a perpetual flu season this year! Help lessen the spread of illness and germs leading to, by adhering to the following common protocols:

Students experiencing digestive or intestinal distress (vomiting, diarrhea) should not return to school until they have been symptom free for 24 hours without preventative medicine.

Students with a fever should remain at home until they have been fever free, without preventative medicine, for 24 hours. Please and thank you!

"Specials" Subs Needed!

All subs are wonderful, but not all the same! Our need is especially great for substitute teachers who are registered through **Edustaff and Brighton** so they can cover for our specialist teachers (Art,

Music, Technology, P.E., Spanish, Library/Media)

The Shared Time program we use , (Brighton) will only pay their subs for the specialist classes through Edustaff . Currently we have only 2 substitutes from the Edustaff AND Brighton systems from which to call upon. If they aren't available, we either have to cancel the classes or pay our IHM subs through our budget, which creates a shortfall.

Edustaff/Brighton subs get paid more than IHM subs. Edustaff /Brighton requires any 4-year-degree, and does not require a teaching certificate.




T.O.B. Tidbit #3

However, by being alone among the animals, Adam realizes that he is different from the rest. He realizes that there is something spiritual about him because only he was made in God's image and likeness. So "original solitude" shows us that Adam was in a unique relationship with God. To have God as the only reference in one's life means that only God can reveal fully who a person is; He is the one with the key to discover one's true identity.

From the Principal:

Hello IHM Families!

We are working to get the registration for the 2025-26 school year open! There are many things to have in place so that when you log in and see your registration form it is all correct. Some of you may remember when we moved to this Finalsite (formerly SchoolAdmin) platform we had many growing pains. We want it to all be there for you. So we are working to put in parishioner statuses and any applicable financial aid before it is open. We will alert you as soon as it's ready- it will likely be a week or two. Current families will have two weeks to complete their registration before we open it up to new families. Those of you needing preschool

enrichment or before or after school Disciple Den will need to make sure you register right away. A couple of VERY important notes around registration:

- If you receive support from ANOTHER parish where you are parishioners, you CAN log in now to request parish support from that parish. When you go to your child's record and scroll down you can see that option. We do not put in that discount until it is approved by the other parish, so if you don't request that support, your contract will show full, non-parishioner tuition.
- If you are an IHM parishioner, you
 do NOT need to request parishioner
 support on Finalsite! You should have
 already filled out your PAPER form and
 turned it in. PLEASE do not send
 requests to Father Troy or anyone else in
 the parish office or school office.
- If you are an IHM parishioner and have not filled out your parishioner form, your contract will show the full, nonparishioner rate for tuition. If you were denied parishioner support, that will show on Finalsite as well.
- Once we open registration, please direct questions about your contracts to the Business Manager, Heather Jablonski, at the parish office.
- Disciple Den registration is now part of the enrollment process. If you check the box that you need before or after school care, a message will pop up for you to choose before school and/or after school and which days of the week. A charge PER DAY for the entire year will automatically be applied to your contract and then spread out for however many payments you choose throughout the year. This eliminates our costs and time associated with Brightwheel and issues around constant fluctuating attendance in our Disciple Den. We will be able to monitor which days fill up more accurately. We would still like to find another teacher for after school so that the older kids have the opportunity for homework and older activities over in the big building.
